I have assigned you Lewis Carroll's *Alice in Wonderland* ISBN-13: 978-0553213454. (You are NOT required to read *Through the Looking Glass*), Cormac McCarthy's *The Road* ISBN-13: 978-0307265432, and Viktor E. Frankl's *Man's Search for Meaning* ISBN-13: 978-0807014295. There will be no substitute titles.

Please bring your annotated texts on the first day of class, and be prepared to have a thoughtful discussion. We will be having a reading check quiz on our second meeting followed by a writing assignment.

Please use the following method to annotate:

- 1. Highlight key words, phrases, or sentences. Write what you find significant in the margins. Highlighting without notes will only help you identify the locations of a passage, but will not help you make meaning.
- 2. Write questions, comments, or connections in the margins.
- 3. Summarize events every few pages.
- 4. Draw a square around unknown words
- 5. Circle words that you find powerful, imaginative, challenging, or emotional.
- 6. Underline major themes/ author's purpose

These will be your first major grades of the year, so please take this seriously.
